Sweet Wrapper Instructions







Just remove the plastic wrapper and re-wrap in the cheapest silver foil you can find as it's really thin. Wrap the whole bar in the paper wrapper and glue...

You can find these bars in Sainsbury's 'Free -From' section











Both the Frys Sandwich and the Cadburys Chocolate are made using Green and Blacks chocolate. I prefer the dark chocolate so am using that. You can get 2 bars out of one if you use the remnance from the first 'slab' and as it's wrapped in foil it holds together.





Again remove the plastic wrapper and re-wrap in thin foil. Wrap the whole bar in the wrapper longways and glue...









I used Sainsbury's 'Doubletake' bars as they come in milk and plain chocolate. The plain can be used for the blue KitKat wrapper. They only come as 2 fingers per Sainsbury's bar so you will need to unwrap two and rewrap them as one with foil to give you the 4 four fingers you need. Add the wrapper and voila - ooh the satisfaction of sliding the chocolate out of the paper wrapper and opening by running your nail down the foil crease...sublime...





Trebor Soft Mints

Remove one sweet from both ends to make the pack smaller. Remove the original paper wrapper - rewrap in silver foil and add the repro paper wrapper
