Matchbook Instructions



Either use the innards of real matchbooks or use matches...



Cut a piece of card or thick paper and glue on matches...



To make it easier to snap the matches they can be scored - but it's not esssential.





Staple them into the matchbook - so the matches can be replaced



Cut a striker board from a box of matches and stick on. Also do this for the box of matches below. For Swan Vestas just encase a modern box of SwanVesta matches with the provided label

Matchbox and Cigarette Instructions

Cut out the cigarette tray and loosen the creases by folding them back and forth. This gives a little more flexibility.

Glue the sleeve together and squash flat. This should allow the aperture to be the correct size. Trim off any extra cardboard. If it doesn't work one way try squashing flat the other way.

The Cigarette tray should be a snug fit in the sleeve so your fags don't slide out!

The England's Glory matches (and other designs) should be glued to a modern England's Glory matchbox
